JANUARY

- ☐ Clean Stove Hood and Filter
- ☐ Clean Refrigerator Condenser Coils
- ☐ Run Oven Cleaning Cycle or Manually Clean Oven
- ☐ Check Windows for Drafts

FEBRUARY

- ☐ Clean Stove Hood and Filter
- ☐ Replace Air Filters
- ☐ Run Dishwasher Cleaning Cycle
- ☐ Clean Refrigerator and Freezer Door Seals
- ☐ Clean Washing Machine Detergent Drawer

MARCH

- ☐ Clean Stove Hood and Filter
- ☐ Replace Air Filters
- ☐ Clean Dryer Lint Trap and Lint Trap Door
- ☐ Check toilets for leaks

APRIL

- ☐ Clean Stove Hood and Filter
- ☐ Replace Air Filters
- ☐ Run Dishwasher Cleaning Cycle
- ☐ Check Dryer Hose for Blockages

MAY

- ☐ Clean Stove Hood and Filter
- ☐ Replace Air Filters
- ☐ Ensure Proper Air Flow Around AC Unit

JUNE

- ☐ Clean Stove Hood and Filter

JULY

- ☐ Clean Stove Hood and Filter

- ☐ Clean Washing Machine Detergent Drawer





HOME ENERGY EFFICIENCY CHECKLIST

ONE-TIME ACTIONS AND ENERGY SAVING TIPS



- Obtain a Programmable Thermostat
- Obtain LED Light bulbs
- Set refrigerator temperature between 35 and 38 degrees
- Run full loads in dishwasher, dryer, and washing machine
- Wash clothes with cold water (check clothes care label)
- Set hot water heater temperature to 120 degrees fahrenheit
- Take baths instead of showers and/or limit showers to 5 minutes
- Clean Dishwasher Filter and Spray Arms Weekly
- Remove Lint from Dryer Lint Drawer After Each Use
- Clean Stove Grates After Each Use
- Do not throw anything away in the toilet
- Change you Air Filter regularly (check product specifications)
- Adjust outdoor watering system seasonally per SNWA guidelines
- Schedule a Summer AC Tune-up every 2-3 years



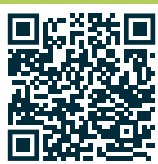
