Why Safety Matters

eBikes and scooters offer fun, affordable transportation—perfect for commuting, cruising trails, or exploring with family and friends. But because they're heavier, faster, and powered by lithium batteries, they come with unique risks.

What riders often don't know:

- Damaged or improperly handled lithium batteries can cause fires.
- Charging incorrectly (when, where, and how long) matters.
- Riders of eBikes under 20 MPH with pedals aren't required to have a driver's license—but they are expected to know the rules of the road.
- Aggressive or unpredictable riding can put you—and others—in danger.
